



TRANSPORTATION GRANT

Who is Northern Corridor Junior Golf?

Northern Corridor Junior Golf was established in 2016 based on the need to coordinate the scheduling of junior golf tournaments in the region of Hearst to Iroquois Falls and Timmins. We coordinated the dates of six (6) junior events and the response by participants, clubs, and parents was very positive. This year, we hope to coordinate the dates of 7-10+ events. We hope to expand participation, increase collaboration and foster a culture of support. NCJG put forward a proposal to the Northern Golf Association (NGA) to help achieve its 2017 objectives. The partnership, through a \$1,000 transportation grant, will help NCJG and the NGA's mission to promote the growth of golf in Northern Ontario.

Eligibility

The following three (3) eligibility criteria must be met to qualify for the grant.

- Junior participant must be a member of a Northern Golf Association member club.
- Tournament must be played on a Northern Golf Association member club course.
- The tournament that the junior participant is traveling to must be included in the NCJG tournament schedule by June 15, 2017.

Funding

- Funding up to \$15 per junior participant to a maximum of \$180 per member club.
- A member club is eligible for up to \$180.
- If money is left over at the end of the golf season, a club could request more than the allowable limit.

Administration

The funding dollars will flow through the member clubs (see claim form).
